RESPONSIBILITIES:

I. ASSISTANT TO THE EXECUTIVE PASTOR

COMMUNICATION

- 1. Communicate with groups and individuals to schedule appointments and meetings.
- 2. Filter and direct calls and meeting requests and when appropriate redirect to other staff and/or lay leaders.
- 3. Partner with XP in follow-up procedures for new givers, financial leaders, etc.

PLANNING AND RESEARCH

- 1. Assist XP by communicating details and preparing needed items for events/ meetings.
- 2. Assist in research and planning as needed for teaching opportunities, ministry documents and meetings.
- 3. Arrange travel for XP (or other staff) when attending conferences or other engagements.
- 4. Research and help implement systems and methodologies to support the growing vision of ALIVE. (ie... additional campuses, church plants, services etc.)
- 5. Assist in developing strategies to utilize and respond to dashboard indicators.

ADMINISTRATION
